GBGH is located in the southern Georgian Bay community of Midland (90 minutes north of Toronto) and serves a catchment area of over 55,000 annual residents and summer population of 200,000. We are considered the gateway to the world famous 30,000 islands of Georgian Bay. This four season community embraces a Georgian Bay lifestyle of summer activities such as boating, sailing, hiking, and golf with winter sports such as cross-country and downhill skiing, snowshoeing, snowmobiling, hockey and curling.

Our catchment area includes over 55,000 annual residents and summer population of 200,000. GBGH is designated as a partial francophone hospital to serve the local French-speaking community. We also are the closest hospital site for Beausoleil First Nation, and provide care to the local indigenous and Metis community. Indigenous cultural safety training is available as well at GBGH. GBGH is a 113 bed hospital.

POSITION SUMMARY:

Hospital based OB/GYN position providing a high quality efficient service with the provision of elective and emergency operating room procedures, and outpatient clinic resources at Georgian Bay General Hospital (GBGH). There is a potential for access to regional resources as part of a regional service. This position would join a team of one permanent OB/GYN at GBGH.

The goal of the Obstetrics program at GBGH is growth of birthing and women's health services.

PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES:

On-Call:

- Provision of on-call services shared with group of 6 OB/Family Physicians
- Participation in any future regional OB/GYN on-call services.

In-Patient:

- Consultations for GBGH credentialed staff and regional partners
- MRP care for inpatients including admission, peri-operative management and discharge
- Participation and cooperation as a contributing team member

Out-Patient:

- Provision of out-patient consultations

Surgery:

- Laparoscopic surgical skills
- C-sections

Administrative and Quality:

- Participation in strategic planning and program development of OB/GYN services.
- Participation in ongoing quality improvement and safety activities related to obstetrical and surgical care.
- Participation in hospital communities pertaining to specialty and as requested by the credentialed staff by-laws
- Active participation as a leader to the Obstetrical Program

Remuneration:

- Alternative Funding Plan to support this position.
- HOCC for on-call
- Community Welcome Package
