The department has a Level II nursery, with approximately 750 annual deliveries. TADH provides equitable access to operating room time and reasonable on-call expectations. The hospital also staffs on-call Pediatricians and provides excellent access to diagnostics.

You will be joining a team that provides exceptional patient and family-driven care, in a supportive trauma-informed, and culturally safe manner. ### Position Requirements

- Candidates must have a Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada certification in Obstetrics and Gynaecology.
- The successful candidate must be eligible to be licensed to practice as an Obstetrician and Gynaecologist in the Province of Ontario and have Canadian Medical Protective Associate (CMPA) coverage.
- A commitment to patient safety and high standards of care.
